OCMM Communications Survey 2012: Report

In October 2012, the OCMM Communications Committee developed a survey on Internet and web access and usage of members and attenders of Old Chatham Monthly Meeting. The survey was completed in November.

The survey was available online and sent to the Meeting email list. Paper surveys were also available. In all, 30 responded online, and 3 on paper. For the last survey, in 2008, 25 surveys were completed online and 8 on paper.

The purpose was primarily to identify the access of Meeting Friends to computers and mobile devices and to email and the Internet as well as their use of the Meeting website and Facebook page.

It is clear that use of computers, email, and the website have increased, as expected, since 2008. It appears that the website is being accessed regularly; the findings on how the website is being used to obtain information are helpful.

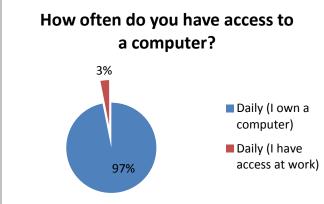
The write-in responses (comments) included: "For those without email, it would be good to send paper copies of the Meeting Update (*we do*); include more photos on the website and Facebook page, not just of the meetinghouse; the email updates are very helpful and much appreciated; we should have biographies of Meeting friends and other news on the website and Facebook page (*agree – anyone can send us this material to post*); please notify by email when business meeting minutes are posted on the website."

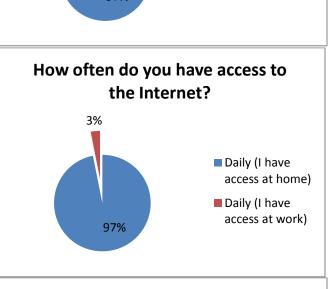
