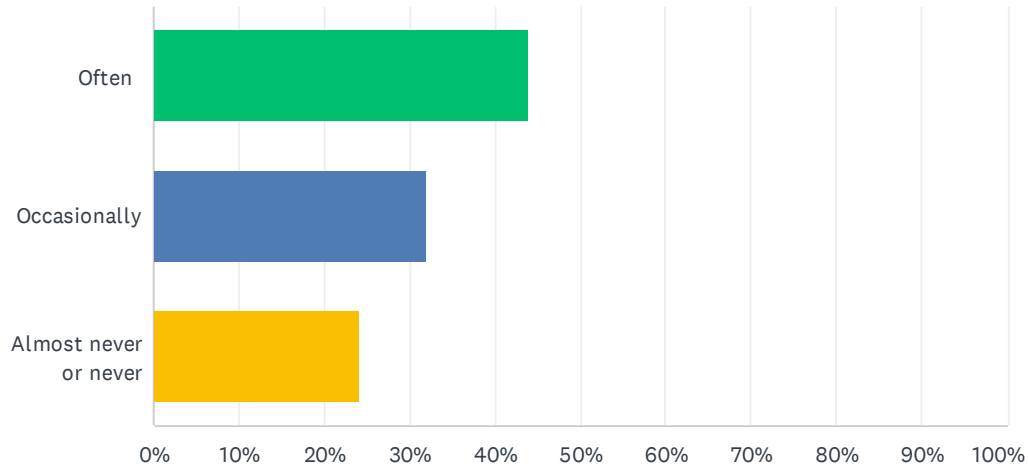


Q1 How often do you attend Sunday morning meeting for worship in person at the meetinghouse?

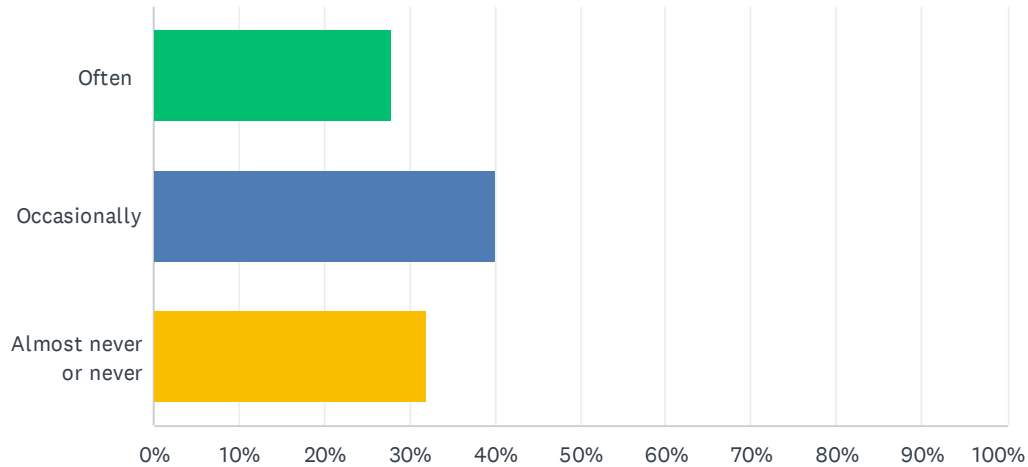

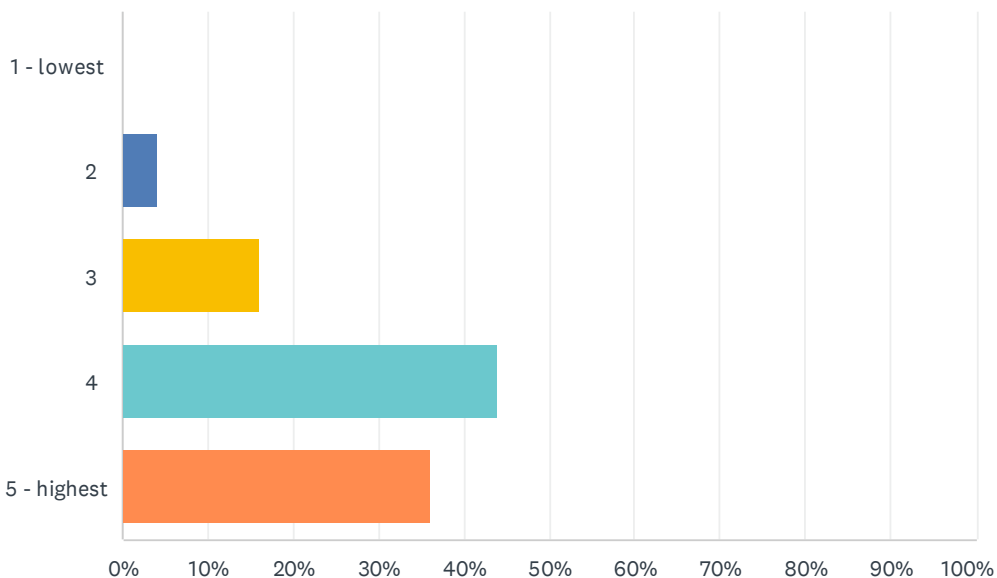

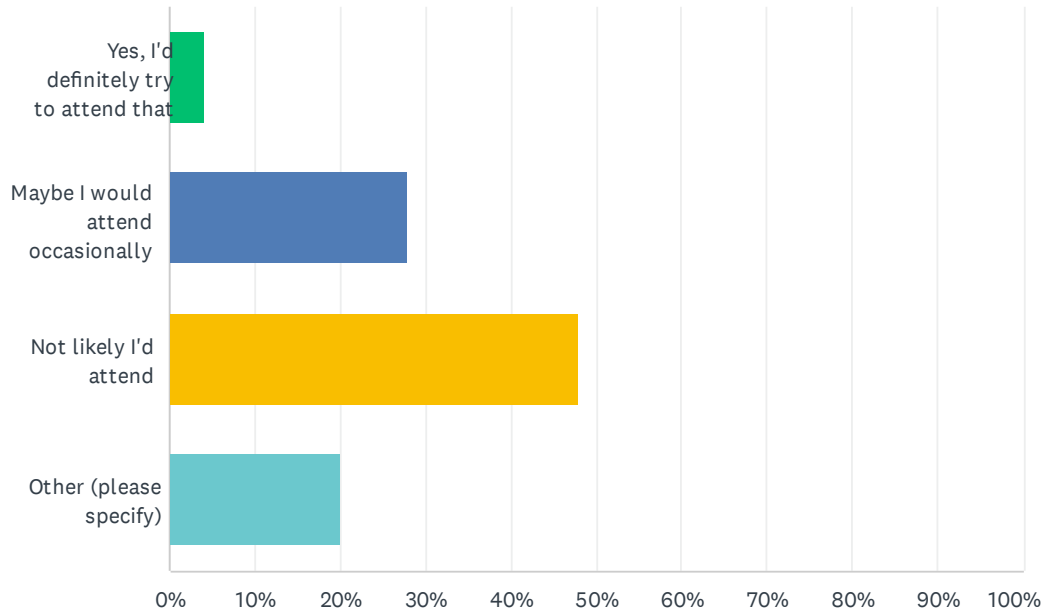

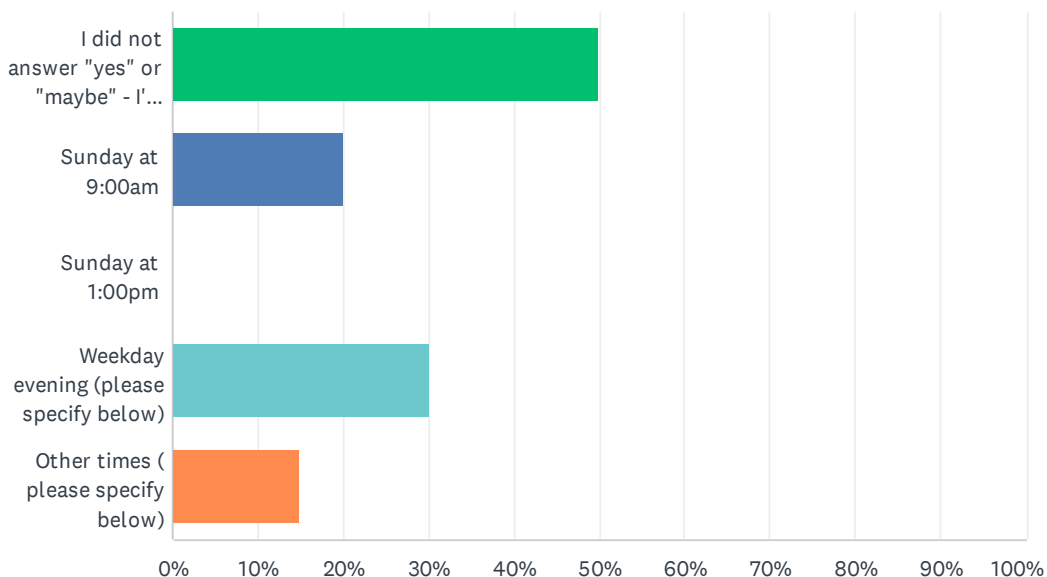

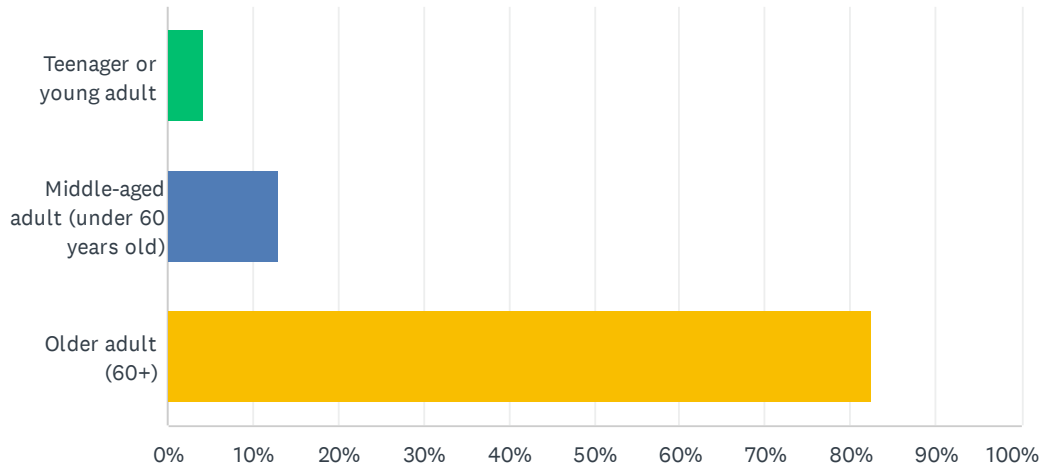

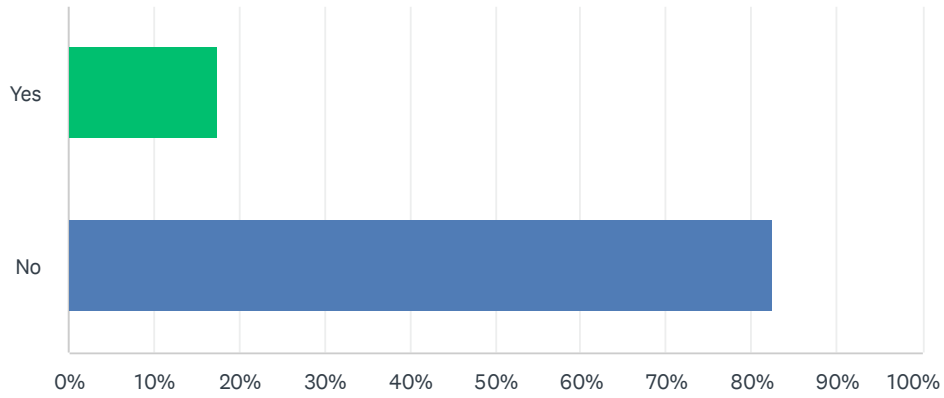

Q9 Do you ever have children (under age 18) accompanying you to Sunday meeting for worship?

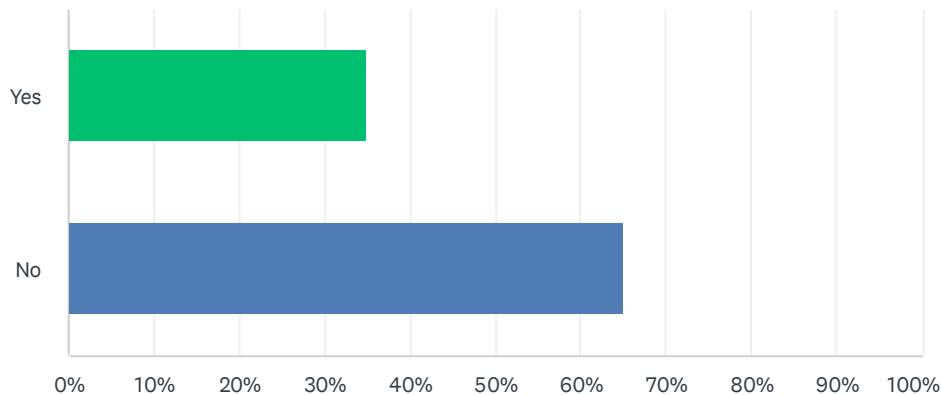
