# Ukraine

- Slightly smaller than Texas, 20-hour drive from east to west
- 44 million people – more than California
- Was part of the Union of Soviet Socialist States (USSR) 1922=1991



Ukraine Soviet Socialist Republic - Borders frequently changed over its 72-year history

2004 – Orange Revolution – Viktor Yushchenko challenged the election – Supreme Court later ruled largely rigged, poisoned him, but came to power

2013 – Revolution of Dignity – Euromaidan protests after Viktor Yanukovich began moving away from an association agreement that had been in the works with the EU and chose to establish closer ties with the Russian Federation. Protests.

2014 – Russian armed intervention and invasion Crimea (Feb. 2014), separatist enclaves in the Donetsk and Luhansk regions – 34 INGOs and 9 UN agencies had a presence before this invasion – primarily concentrated in east 2 regions– Russian-backed separatists vs. Ukr military – e.g., ICRC, WFP, Save the Children, Norwegian Refugee Council helping over 1.4 million IDPs, more than 10K civilians killed or injured, more than 3 million in need before this latest crisis. Very high % of vulnerable people affected: elderly and persons with disabilities account for more than 30% of the people living in conflict-affected Ukraine, according to the UN pre-war Feb. 24, 2022 invasion

- Why do I want to help? For what purposes?
- Who decided what type of help is needed and how did they decide that?
- Does the help apply limited resources in ways that maximally address gaps?
- Does the help have any potential to cause harm?

# PICKING AN ORGANIZATION TO DONATE TO

WHEN PEOPLE OUTSIDE MY HOME COMMUNITY FACE A HUMANITARIAN CRISIS

- ✘ Does the organization already have people and partners on the ground?
- ✘ Does the organization routinely do this kind of humanitarian work?
- ✘ Does the organization have the capacity to absorb significant increases in funding?
- ✘ Does the organization have a close connection to direct implementation of the humanitarian response?
- ✘ Does the organization have professionals making market salaries?
- ✘ Does the organization have the capacity to monitor use of funds?
